

# St Colman's Care Centre, Achill Calendar 2012 Digital Photography Competition

## Rules and Regulations

1. The Achill Calendar is produced in A4 landscape format. It is advisable therefore that all photographs be taken in landscape format so that they are suitable for publication in the calendar.
2. The judging panel will be an independent group chosen by the organisers of the competition and the decisions of the panel will be final. No correspondence will be entered into under any circumstances in relation to the results of the competition.
3. Each entry (maximum 3 images) must include a non-refundable contribution of €10.00, payable by Cash, Cheque or Money Order to St Colman's Care Centre - (Registered Charity no. CHY16473). Payment can only be accepted in Euros. Each entrant will be issued with a receipt sent by email to the email address provided on the entry form.
4. A person may enter the competition as often as he/she wishes.
5. All entries must be received on or before 31<sup>st</sup> October 2010. No entries will be accepted after this date.
6. Participants must submit A4 print(s) of the submitted photograph(s) in full colour, un-mounted and unframed, attached by a paper clip to the entry form.
7. Each print submitted must have a LABEL ON THE BACK, with the photograph title, when and where the image was taken, name and address of entrant, telephone no. and email address. No personal information will be used outside of its necessity for the competition.
8. Each entry must include copies of the photograph(s) in JPEG High resolution format on DVD or CD that can be opened and processed on standard computers. *Images cannot be accepted by email.*
9. The submitted photograph(s) must be accompanied by the relevant entry form. The entrant must be the author of the photograph(s) submitted. ***The photograph(s) must not have been published previously in any form.***
10. The entrant must obtain any releases or authorisations required, which are the sole responsibility of the entrant. If a photograph contains a readily identifiable person as a subject, the entrant must ask permission to use their image(s) and have them, or their parent or guardian, sign the waiver on the entry form.
11. The entrant must certify that nothing exists that may interfere with their entering the photograph(s) in this competition or granting of authorisations to use the photographs in the calendar or otherwise.
12. The photograph(s) submitted must not be defamatory, offensive or obscene or violate or infringe on the trademark, copyright, publicity, privacy or other rights of any third party.
13. In submitting photograph(s) to this competition the entrant irrevocably grants to **St Colman's Care Centre, Achill Island** and its employees, officers and assigns (hereinafter referred to as "RELEASED PARTIES"), the right to use, reproduce, adopt, distribute, alter, publish and publicly display the photograph(s) that are the subject of this Agreement for any purpose in relation to the promotion, distribution and sale of the Achill Calendar, and to attach the entrant's name to the photograph(s).
14. All entry forms, submissions, photographs, cd's and dvd's will be retained by the organisers of the competition, but will only be used by them under the terms of these Rules and Regulations.
